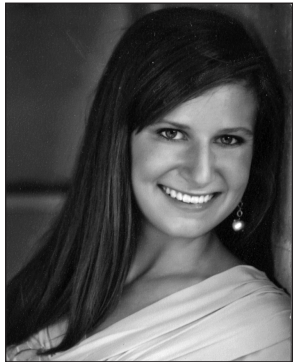


MPMC SA 2011-2012 SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS

ANNE CASSIDY PRINCE

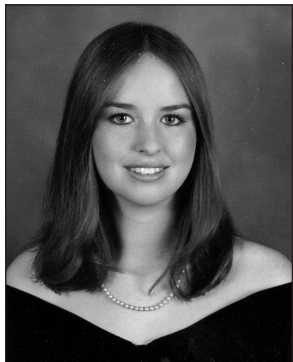


Anne Cassidy is the daughter of Ellen and Eric Prince, Prince Oil Company, Philadelphia, MS.
